
Client referral program



Budget highlights of the 2023/2024 tax proposals are: Adjustments upwards of 10% to tax tables for transfer duty, Adjusting the personal income tax brackets and rebates in line retirement fund lump sum benefits and retirement fund lump with the expected inflation rate of 4.9%.

Budget 2023 – impact on SARS tax rates, duties and levies




